0. INTRODUCTION

The ENERinTOWN project addresses the need which has been detected to establish greater control over energy consumption in municipally-owned buildings, by providing a solution which will enable the two existing barriers to be eliminated: lack of detailed knowledge on consumption figures and lack of qualified local personnel with the capacity to propose improvement actions.

The project includes the following actions:

- Identification of buildings to be monitored.
- Design and introduction of a system for monitoring gas and electricity consumption in buildings, with data transmitted continuously over Internet to a central management unit.
- Creation of the figure of the local or district (pan-municipal) energy manager and establishment of a methodology for collaboration with the regional energy agency.
- Creation of a computer municipal energy management application for interpreting and processing the monitored data.
- Creation of a municipal guide to procuring equipment and designing buildings using energy criteria.
- Introduction of low-cost measures and assessment of results.
- Dissemination actions targeted at owners of buildings in the EU.
